

#### In and around the Bee Yard

This section is to highlight some considerations for your apiary this time of year. For specifics, it is suggested that you read, research, talk to other beekeepers as well as document what you do so you can refer back and decide what works best for you and your bees.

#### **Honey Bee Activity**: June (Honey Bees)

Bees will be looking for food sources. Robbing will begin and increase and nectar sources dwindle.

#### **Beekeeper Duties:**

- Main nectar flow starts to dwindle---fewer supers needed
- Extract honey and put "wet" supers back on hives <u>late</u> in day to limit robbing.
- Start late-season splits during last half of June; feed splits initially, even if there is nectar available
  - Control small hive beetle population (hahaha)
    - Keep water for bees constantly available
- Equalize hive strengths, boost weak hives up and reduce entrances to help with robbing

#### **Beekeeper Activities:**

#### Attend club meeting and get involved.

-Call your State Bee Inspector and set an appointment for later in the year for them to come out and inspect your hive WITH YOU.

- Keep records up to date

--Mentor a new Beekeeper & plan to attend the **Summer NCSBA meeting in July.**
