A poor location will always be a poor location – regardless of what the beekeeper does.

Wants: Sun - forage - water

### Beekeeper Skillset:

- ✓ Honeybee needs
- ✓ Location assessment
- ✓ Relationships w/ farmers & their crops know their pesticides!

## use Good Comb

Old comb is a storage for pesticides and pathogens.

Comb cells become smaller over time - cramping brood.

✓ Rotate comb every 3-5 seasons.

- ✓ Pay attention to old comb
- ✓ Track comb / date frames
- ✓ Notice colony differences
- ✓ Be disciplined and replace

With just a few hives it is easy to forget:

- > Queen heritage
- > Honey production
- > Treatment schedules
- > Actions needed

### Item 7:

## Keep Records

- ✓ Maintain logbook
- ✓ Make decisions based on fact not memory
- ✓ <u>Plan</u> your beekeeping

Assess Hives > Quarterly

At least 4 times per year a FULL assessment of bee and colony health needs to be performed.

- ✓ colony assessment
- ✓ Queen performance
- ✓ % of types of brood
- ✓ Signs of infection
- ✓ Resource analysis

# Buy (or make) NEW Equipment

Old equipment is a good way to spread disease and promote health problems.

- ✓ Never buy used equipment
- ✓ Replace old equipment
- ✓ Standardíze on equipment
